Updated Registry Quality Measures

GEHRIMED has updated the following measures to comply with the 2021 CMS MIPS CQM specifications.

- Quality ID #006: Coronary Artery Disease (CAD): Antiplatelet Therapy
- Quality ID #236: Controlling High Blood Pressure

- Added Denominator Criteria: Denominator Exclusion: (G2118)
- Updated Denominator Statement and Denominator Note
- Updated Numerator Note
- Updated Measure Description, Instructions, and Clinical Recommendation Statements
- Added denominator exclusion codes for identifying frailty and advanced illness

Issues Addressed

- A typo in Diabetes Quality Measure has been corrected.
- In some cases, QM Search did not display results for Quality Measure 155 correctly. This has been resolved.
- The vitals fields now retain zeros that occur after a decimal point. This applies to Weight, BMI, Pulse, Blood Pressure, o2 Saturation, o2 Flow Rate, Temperature, Respiratory Rate, Blood Sugar, and Pain Level.
- An issue causing duplicate Procedure records to be added in Patient Details has been resolved.
- The Quality Measure scorecard now correctly displays available measure points for topped out measure. This applies to QMs 93, 130, 283, and 286.
